30-Day Prayer Guide *Pray for America*

DISCERN

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. —Proverbs 3:5-6

Day 1

Discernment to Recognize God’s Voice

That Americans of faith would have ears to hear divine guidance above the noise of culture and politics.

Day 2

Discernment in Churches

That religious leaders and congregations would seek God’s wisdom above cultural or political pressures.

Day 3

Discernment for Parents

That families would be guided in raising children with insight, moral grounding, and a love for truth.

Day 4

Discernment for National Leaders

That those in positions of power would seek Jesus and His truth over personal or political gain.

Day 5

Discernment for the Next Generation

That young people would be grounded in truth and equipped to lead with wisdom.

DEVELOP

Practice these things, immerse yourself in them, so that all may see your progress. —1 Timothy 4:15

Day 6

Develop: Spiritual Development Across the Nation

That there would be a revival of faith, moral integrity, and a deeper relationship with God in every community.

Day 7

Develop: Leadership Development

That a new generation of wise, humble, and servant-hearted leaders would be raised up across all sectors.

Day 8

Develop: Community Development

That there would be stronger neighborhoods, safer streets, and initiatives that build trust and cooperation among residents.

Day 9

Develop: Youth Development

That young people would be nurtured in character, courage, and purpose as they grow into future leaders.

Day 10

Develop: National Unity and Identity Development

That America would grow in understanding its shared values and purpose while embracing its diverse people.

DEFEND

Learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow’s cause. —Isaiah 1:17

Day 11

Defend Religious Freedom

Ask for continued protection of the right to worship, preach, and live out faith publicly without fear or compromise.

Day 12

Defend the Unborn and the Sanctity of Life

Pray for laws, leaders, and hearts that protect life from conception to natural death.

Day 13

Defend the Family Structure

Pray for strong marriages and families, and for protection against cultural forces that seek to dismantle God’s design for the family.

Day 14

Defend the Truth in a Time of Deception

Pray that God would raise up voices to boldly stand for truth in media, education, and government.

Day 15

Defend Justice for the Oppressed

Pray for fair treatment under the law for all people, and for courage to confront corruption and inequality.

DECLARE

...Rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. —2 Corinthians 13:11

Day 16

Declare a Return to God’s Word as the Foundation of Truth

Pray that Scripture would be honored in homes, schools, churches, and government.

Day 17

Declare Peace Over Divided Communities

Speak unity and healing into places torn by political, racial, or ideological conflict.

Day 18

Declare Truth Over Deception in Media and Culture

Proclaim that truth will rise above lies, confusion, and propaganda.

Day 19

Declare Unity Among Believers

Pray that the Church would lead the way in reconciliation and love across denominations, races, and regions.

Day 20

Declare Protection Over America’s Families and Children

Proclaim God’s covering over the hearts, minds, and future of the next generation.

DISCIPLE

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. —John 13:34-35

Day 21

Disciple: Pray for a Culture of True Discipleship in the American Church

Ask that churches would focus on deep, relational, Christ-centered discipleship.

Day 22

Disciple: Pray for Pastors and Leaders to Be Disciple-Makers

Intercede for spiritual leaders to model and multiply Christ-like character.

Day 23

Disciple: Pray for the Discipleship of the Next Generation

Lift up children, teens, and young adults to be grounded in truth, mentored in faith, and equipped to stand strong.

Day 24

Disciple: Pray for a Revival of Biblical Literacy

Ask that believers would hunger for God’s Word and be rooted in sound doctrine, not cultural trends.

Day 25

Disciple: Pray for Families to Be Centers of Discipleship

Pray that parents and grandparents would take spiritual leadership in the home seriously, discipling their children with love and intentionality.

DEDICATE

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. —Colossians 2:6-7

Day 26

Dedicate the Nation to God’s Sovereign Rule

Pray that America would be consecrated to God’s purposes, acknowledging Him as the true source of blessing and authority.

Day 27

Dedicate Leaders at Every Level to Integrity and Justice

Ask God to raise up leaders in government, business, education, and media who are devoted to truth and moral leadership.

Day 28

Dedicate the Church in America to Holiness and Mission

Pray that churches across the country would be set apart for Christ, committed to purity, worship, and outreach.

Day 29

Dedicate the Next Generation to God’s Calling

Intercede for children and youth to grow in faith, purpose, and obedience to God’s voice amid cultural noise.

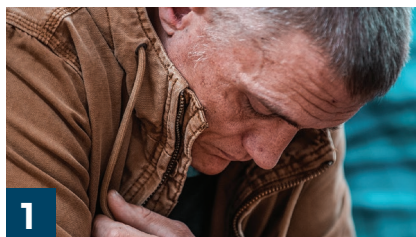
Day 30
